

# W.E.E.D.S. = Winter Euclid Extreme Disc Series

## Rules and Format:

1. All rules of play are adopted from the most recent version of the P.D.G.A. Official Rules of Disc Golf. However, final decisions will be made by the tournament director if there is a disagreement on the interpretation of a rule or an occurrence during play. Participants do not have to be P.D.G.A. member to participate
2. 2 meter rule is not in affect during this series unless otherwise noted by the tournament director prior to the start of play.
3. Bag tag fees, registration fees, W.E.E.D.S. championship tournament fund will all be paid out 100% during the series (all in cash unless other expenses are incurred., i.e. the cost of providing a lunch for a tournament)
4. There will be 2 divisions, Pro and Am. For the "Usual Euclid Suspects", Pro is equivalent to playing "A" during Monday scrambles and Am is equivalent to playing "B" during Monday scrambles. This format was chosen given the local turnout and familiarity. Divisions are subject to change due to tournament attendance. (There is a possibility of putting in a woman's division or a masters division if we can get at least 4 woman/masters to regularly participate.) However, it is noted that smaller divisions equal smaller payout per division.
5. The top 40% of the field will be paid out for the first three tournaments.
6. Registration Fees:
  - a. Pro - \$17 (\$15 gets paid out at the event, \$2 goes into W.E.E.D.S. championship tournament fund)
  - b. Am - \$12 ((\$10 gets paid out at the event, \$2 goes into W.E.E.D.S. championship tournament fund)
  - c. Bag Tag - \$10 (one time purchase)
7. Points will be earned throughout the first 3 events. Points will be awarded to all participants based on their position in their division at the end of the event. No points will be awarded to participants who do not complete their rounds.
8. A \$10 bag tag is to be purchased at W.E.E.D.S. #1 for participation in the W.E.E.D.S. The money for the bag tag will go into the W.E.E.D.S. championship tournament fund. There will be a set of bag tags for each division (Pro and Am). Bag tags can be obtained at W.E.E.D.S. #2 and W.E.E.D.S. #3. Obviously, the less events you play in, the less amount of point you have the ability to earn. It is possible to play in the W.E.E.D.S. without a bag tag, although it is discouraged, however, players who participate it W.E.E.D.S. events but choose not to purchase a bag tag forfeit their \$2 W.E.E.D.S. championship tournament fund and will not be able to participate in the W.E.E.D.S. championship tournament. However, they can elect to opt in after any of the events by purchasing a bag tag, but any points earned prior to purchasing the bag tag do not count towards their "bag tag" ranking. If a player opts in after W.E.E.D.S. #3, they will be placed in the lowest ranking spot at that time.
9. At the beginning of each event, each participant will give up their bag tag. At the end of the event, the bag tags will be redistributed based on their points standings after that event has been completed.
10. At the end of the first 3 events, the bag tag that each participant receives will be their ranking in the W.E.E.D.S. Championship tournament.
11. The W.E.E.D.S. events or Championship tournament is not sanctioned by the P.D.G.A. but the intention is to run these events as much as like a P.D.G.A. event as possible without the annoying rule arguments. Final decisions on rules, arguments and discrepancies will be made by the tournament director. In the event the tournament director participates in the W.E.E.D.S. and he is involved in a rule discrepancy, a final decision will be based on a majority decision by the other members on the tournament director's card.

NOTE: Being this is the inaugural year for the W.E.E.D.S., all these rules, dates, formats and other aspects of the series are subject to change based on feedback and other info.

Fees: Pro - \$17, Am - \$12  
Format: 2 rounds at Sims Park – 20 holes/rounds  
          Pro – 2 rounds from long tees  
          Am – 2 rounds from short tees

Name: The Tundra Saucer Toss Takeoff  
Place: C.C.A. Disc Golf Course - Richmond Heights  
Fees: Pro - \$17, Am - \$12  
Format: 2 rounds at C.C.A. – 18 holes per round  
          Pro & Am – 2 rounds - all tees  
          • 9 holes – long tees, 9 holes – short tees (each round – subject to change)

## W.E.E.D.S. #3

Name: The Frozen Saucer Open  
Place: Sims Park – Euclid and C.C.A. Disc Golf Course – Richmond Heights  
Fees: Pro - \$17, Am - \$12  
Format: 1 round at Sims Park – 20 holes  
          1 round at C.C.A. - 21 holes (9 long, 9 short, 3 added)

## W.E.E.D.S. Championship Tournament

Name: W.E.E.D.S. Championship Tournament  
Place: Sims Park – Euclid and C.C.A. Disc Golf Course – Richmond Heights  
Fees: \$5 per match  
Format: Based on the rankings determined during the first 3 events, each participant will be placed in a tournament style bracket (win – move on, lose – go home) within their own division (Pro and Am). The size of the brackets and how many participants will be in each bracket depends on how many people participate. The day of your match (which is determined by the 2 participants), each participant will pay \$5 for the match. The winner of the match takes the \$5 and moves on. The loser of the match loses his \$5 and goes home. This keeps on going until we are left with 2 participants in each division. The winner of each division will get 65% of the W.E.E.D.S. tournament fund generated by their division; the runner-up will get 35%. Again, the W.E.E.D.S. tournament fund is generated by the \$10 received from each bag tag and the \$2 of each registration fee per event. The course format is as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> round – Sims Park  
2<sup>nd</sup> round – CCA  
Semis - Sims Park  
Finals – Sims Park and CCA

(Rounds and locations are subject to change based on participation)

- a \$2 optional ace fund will be offered at each of the first 3 W.E.E.D.S. events but not the W.E.E.D.S. Championship Tournament.
